## 7/8 November 2009 Open Canoe Course

I am planning to run a 2 day open (Canadian) canoe course to 2 star level. These skills will be assessed as part of the 2 Star award.

This will cover the basic strokes, handling, recovery, capsize drills and journeying.

There are a limited number of places (6). If you are interested please contact Barry.

The first day will be at Tatershall playing around the pontoons. The second day will be a long trip around the Newark Loop (8 miles) to finish on the weir learning to ferry glide across the moving water breaking in and out in tandem.

## Sunday mornings – November/December Grantham – River Witham

We are planning to run a number of trips through Grantham to play on the weirs. This is normally a 2-3 hour trip. These will be short notice trips due to the weather at this time of the year. I or Dane will put out a txt/email a couple of days before to find out who is interested.
